Before starting his own business, Kenneth worked in the 'hot end' at Ball Brothers Glass plant until it closed in the late 1980's. Following that crossroads in their lives, Kenneth and Linda made the brave choice to start Adams Pest Control. With lots of blood, sweat, tears and prayer, they built that business for over 30 years and made it the successful enterprise it is today. Ken loved his family, and will always be remembered for his antics, especially in his younger years. He loved banana pudding, peppermint candy, and he loved the Rocky Mountains.
