Alice B. Dangott died May 28, 2020. She was born December 7, 1926 in Henryetta, Oklahoma. She was the daughter of Pat and Laura Badger of Okmulgee, both of whom preceded her in death.

She graduated from Okmulgee High School in 1943 and attended Smith College in Northampton, Massachusetts. She graduated in June, 1947. She received a Masters of Education degree from Oklahoma University in June, 1950.

On April 16, 1955 she married Robert Glen Dangott. They had two daughters, Laura Keane of Las Cruces, New Mexico and Judith Ann Dangott, both of whom preceded her in death.

She was an active member of First United Methodist Church. She was a member of Chapter Z, PEO, and an honorary member of Sesame Club and Art & Literature Club. She was also active in the Okmulgee Memorial Hospital Auxiliary.
