Anna Barbara Annemie Waldroop went to be with her Lord on December 17m 2011 at the age of 87. She was born April 30, 1924 to Johann & Anna Popp. Her birthplace was Nussbuehl, in Bavaria, Germany.

She met her future husband, Glen Waldroop in Bayreuth, Germany, where he was stationed after WWII. They both worked at the U.S. Armed Forces post office.
