Barbara Thompson, 87, longtime resident of Okmulgee, passed away in Okmulgee on Thursday, October 27, 2011. She was born in Tulsa on January 13, 1924 to Lowell Egbert and Fannie Fray (Wilson) Hicks. Barbara moved to Okmulgee in 1952 with her husband Donald. Donald worked for Ball Brothers Glass, and later joined Viersen & Cochran Oil Company in 1955.
