



Bertha Lee Edmonds

December 16, 1919 - June 21, 2011

Bertha Lee (Perry) Edmonds died in Tulsa on Tuesday, June 21, 2011 at 91 years of age. Bertha was born on December 16, 1919 in Harrison, Arkansas to Moses Dow and Wadie Ann (Golding) Perry. On July 13, 1935 she married Granville V. Edmonds in Seminole, Oklahoma. In the 1960's they owned the Morris Café. Bertha retired as Ward Clerk of the Okmulgee Memorial Hospital after 20 years. Bertha was a hard worker. She was a member of the Trinity Baptist Church in Morris, Oklahoma, the Eastern Star and the Morris Senior Citizen Center.

Bertha was preceded in death by her husband, Granville, on February 1, 1988 and a son, Don E. Edmonds on October 2, 2004.

She is survived by two daughters: Phyllis Shoemake and husband Max of Morris, Linda June Hildebrandt and husband David of Broken Arrow, daughter-in-law Marjorie Edmonds of Morris, seven grandchildren: Don V.
