Betty Miller Reamer, lifelong Okmulgee resident, passed away Friday, October 7, 2016 at St. Francis Hospital in Tulsa. She was 97 years of age. Betty was born January 17, 1919 in Okmulgee to the late Gus and Nannie (Thomas) Miller. She graduated from Okmulgee High School in 1937 and later married E.G."Bud" Reamer. Betty worked at the Okmulgee County Court House, Okmulgee Abstract Office and then retired from Pine Properties after 38 years. She had been an avid bowler and a Pony Girl. Betty had also served as a leader in Weight Watchers, was a member of the Morris Assembly of God, the Ladies Outreach Red Hat Group and the First Priority Club. She loved to knit and crochet, having made 167 framed names for her family and friends.
