Bill Edward “Eddie” Hennigan, 74 year old Okmulgee resident, passed away October 30, 2017 in Tulsa. He was born January 19, 1943 in Wichita, Kansas to B.E. and Annetta Faye (Johns) Hennigan. Eddie grew up in Ada and graduated from Ada High School. At the age of 19, Eddie moved to Okmulgee to attend OSU-Tech. He then went to work at East Central Electric and retired after 47 years of service as the Director of Office Services. Eddie was diagnosed with Muscular Dystrophy at the age 14; however, he lived life without excuses. He married Patty Fuller on June 25, 1979 in Tulsa. He was a member of the Episcopal Church of the Redeemer and an active member of Muscular Dystrophy Association. He enjoyed listening to music, watching OU sporting events, jeep trails in the mountains of Colorado and New Mexico and the Okmulgee Game Refuge. 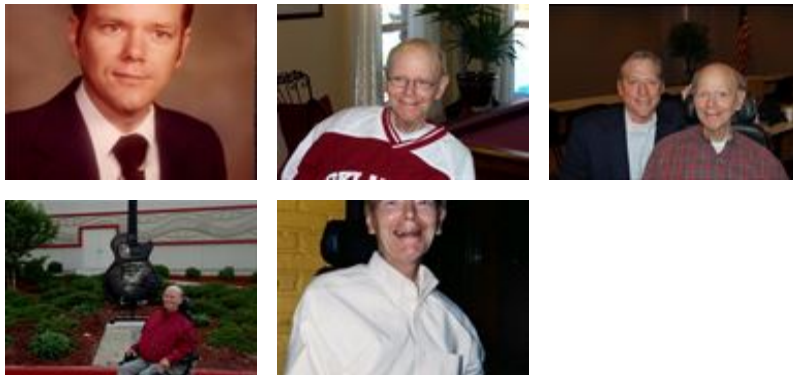
