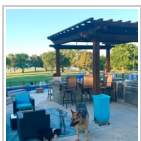
“Bobby, you are already missed by so many. Always ready with a joke, so quick to laugh. This place will not be the same without you.

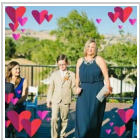
