



Carl Dean Denton

September 17, 1929 - February 12, 2017

Carl Dean Denton, longtime Okmulgee resident, passed away surrounded by his family, Sunday, February 12, 2017 at his home. He was 87 years of age. Carl was born September 17, 1929 in Yale, Oklahoma to the late George Ralph and Ruby Willow (Bowen) Denton. He served his country in the United States Navy and received an Honorable Discharge in May of 1954. Carl married Peggy Virginia Adair on November 27, 1952 in Stillwell. He taught Diesel Mechanics at OSU Tech for 17 years, retiring in 1984. He was a member of the First Assembly of God Church in Okmulgee, Masonic Lodge 199 of Okmulgee and the Morris Lions Club. He loved riding his motorcycles and boating.

Carl was preceded in death by his parents, a son, Michael Denton, Sr., siblings, George W. Denton, Raymond "Scotty" Denton, Lena Corralia Ray, Lillie Francis Maxey, Ola Mae Slaughter and Harry Denton.
