Carl Eugene King was born May 26, 1938 in Eram, Oklahoma to the late Raymond and Opal Grace (Naumann) King. He passed away Saturday, November 26, 2022 at eighty-four years of age. Carl was united in marriage to Mary Lou Hopkins on June 3, 1961, in Morris. He began his teaching career in Eram, moving to Jenks and later returning to Okmulgee to work at OSU-IT, then Nuyaka, Liberty and Morris, all while doing what he loved most, farming and ranching.
