Charles Lee Rogers was born October 9, 1941 in Wichita Falls, Texas to the late Charlie and Johnnie Lee (Evans) Rogers. He passed away Sunday, March 29, 2020 in Tulsa at 78 years of age. In 1950 the family moved from Texas and made their home in Okmulgee. Charles graduated from Okmulgee High School and served his country in the United States Army. He worked for the Oklahoma State Parks beginning in 1964 and retiring in 1999. He was an avid hunter, fisherman and sports fan. He also enjoyed old cars and classic movies. Charles was a member of the Okmulgee Elks Lodge and the VFW Post 1189.
