



## Charles E. Coyne

December 15, 1933 - January 29, 2012

Charles E. Coyne, a long time Miami resident passed away at his home on January 29, 2012 at the age of 78. Mr. Coyne was born on December 15, 1933 in Estella, Oklahoma to Emmett and Theresia (Altebaumer) Coyne. He was a member of the United States Navy during the Korean Conflict as a Radarman Third Class when he was honorably discharged. On September 5, 1960 at Holy Ghost Catholic Church in Vinita, Charles married the love of his life Patsy Griffith. They lived in the Vinita area for a short time before moving to Miami. Mr. Coyne worked at B.F. Goodrich where he cured tires and then worked as a final inspector. He also worked for years as the janitor at the First Christian Church. For fun, Mr. Coyne loved to tease and love others, but most of all, he loved his family.
