Christopher John Bell was called home on March 15, 2011 at the age of 41. Chris was born December 16, 1969 in Tulsa to John and Kathryn (Kemler) Bell. He graduated from Beggs High School in 1988 and attended the University of Oklahoma majoring in Mechanical Engineering and Oklahoma State University-Okmulgee majoring in Drafting. Chris specialized in custom automotive paint and body as well as being a gifted artist. Chris loved his son Aaron, and his family and there was never a kinder heart than his. He had a passion for building high performance cars, boats and motorcycles. He was baptized and raised in the First Assembly of God Church in Beggs. He was co-owner of Quality 1 Auto Sales with his brother Jesse.

He was preceded in death by his paternal grandfather Fred Bell, maternal grandfather Alison Bentley and paternal great grandmothers Mattie Cockrun and Esther Bell.

Chris is survived by his parents, John and Kathryn (Kemler) Bell of Beggs, his son, Aaron Bell of the home, brother Jesse Bell of Beggs, paternal grandmother Mary Lou Bell of Beggs, Uncle and Aunt, Jack and Freda Bell of Beggs, cousins Mary and Rod Bell of Beggs and the mother of his son, T.J. My name is Laura... was Patterson then and I know his folks will remember me.

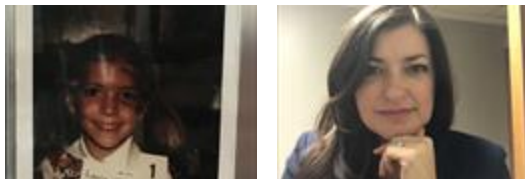
