Cliff K. Parker went home to be with his Lord and Savior on Friday, June 25, 2010 in Okmulgee at the age of 73. Cliff was born January 25, 1937 in Catalee, Oklahoma to Alvie and Clara (Cates) Parker. He graduated from Morris High School in 1956 where he played football and basketball. He married Carolyn Sue Southwick on April 27, 1957 at the First Baptist Church of Morris.
