Curtis L. Bundy, age 78, passed away surrounded by his family on April 11, 2026, in Okmulgee, Oklahoma. He was born on April 15, 1947, in Holdenville, Oklahoma, to A.C. and Dewey (Jackson) Bundy.

Curtis graduated from Seminole High School in 1965. He married Dianah Smith on June 17, 1978, in Seminole, Oklahoma.
