



## Cynthia Louise Factor

October 22, 1943 - March 26, 2016

Cynthia Louise Factor was born October 22, 1943 in Claremore to the late Walter Factor and the late Lucille (Fields) Factor. She passed away on Saturday, March 26, 2016 in Tulsa at 72 years of age. Cynthia was employed by the Tulsa Public Health Department as a purchasing agent. She was a member of the Tallahassee Indian Methodist Church and was proud of her Muscogee (Creek) heritage. She enjoyed sewing, traveling, square dancing, bowling and playing golf, but her greatest love was spending time with her family, especially her grandkids.
