David Clinton Luster, 72 year old Edmond resident, passed away Thursday, September 6, 2018 in Ft. Smith, Arkansas. He was born April 19, 1946 in Tulsa to the late Vernon and Johnnie (Campbell) Luster. His early years were spent in Beggs before the family relocated to Maud. David graduated from Maud High School in 1964 and Northeastern State University in 1968. He served his country in the U.S. Army and worked in the energy industry for forty years. David enjoyed hunting, fishing and playing golf. He always looked forward to opening the Camp David gate and enjoying his farm.

David was a 50 year Mason and currently a member of the Beggs Masonic Lodge #319, where he was Past Master. He was also the Past Master of the Ada Masonic Lodge #119.
