Della M. Hill, 81, a resident of Beggs, died Saturday afternoon, September 14, 2013 at her residence. Della was born June 1, 1932 in Broken Arrow, Oklahoma to Odie and Ruby (Buttress) Fox. She married Tommie Hill on November 8, 1949 in Van Buren, Ark.

Della graduated valedictorian from Preston High School in 1949. Her and her husband owned Hills Dry Goods and later, Hills New and Used Furniture for many years. She enjoyed flower gardening and was a member of the First Baptist Church of Beggs. She was preceded in death by her parents, husband, and a brother, Ralph Fox.

Survivors include her daughters, Brenda Helms and husband David of Muskogee and Diana Baughn and husband Kenneth of Beggs, a son, Kennard Hill and wife Marsha of Okmulgee, ten grandchildren and nineteen great grandchildren.
