Delores LaVonne Peterson, longtime Okmulgee resident, died in Tulsa on May 7, 2014 at 88 years of age. LaVonne was born in Okmulgee on August 14, 1925 to Earl Prescott and Leva (Phillips) VanDolsen. She was a graduate of Okmulgee High School, Class of 1943. LaVonne worked as a secretary at the George Nigh Rehab Center until her retirement in 1993. 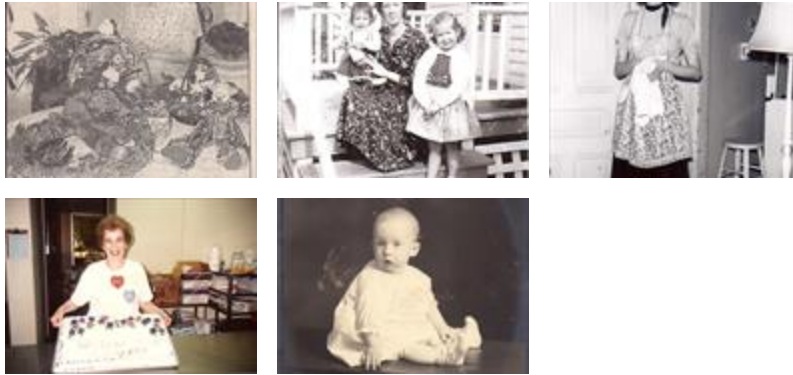
