Diane (McCarty) Prentice, longtime Okmulgee resident, died Sunday, September 9, 2012 at her home. She was 65 years of age. Diane was born January 30, 1947 in Ft. Smith, Arkansas to the late Bill McCarty, Jr. and Clara (Dupuis) McCarty. She married Frank M. Prentice on February 1, 1964 in Shawnee. Diane loved her family and the time she was able to spend with her children and grandchildren. She was a member of the Second Baptist Church and enjoyed the time she spent reading her bible. Prior to Diane's failing health, she taught school at the Bible Baptist Academy, worked at the Okmulgee Daily Times and Citizens Bank.
