Doris Jean Wright, longtime Okmulgee resident, passed away peacefully on June 10, 2025 at the age of 94. She was born September 25, 1930 in Nella, Arkansas to Samuel and Mona (Johnson) Garner. 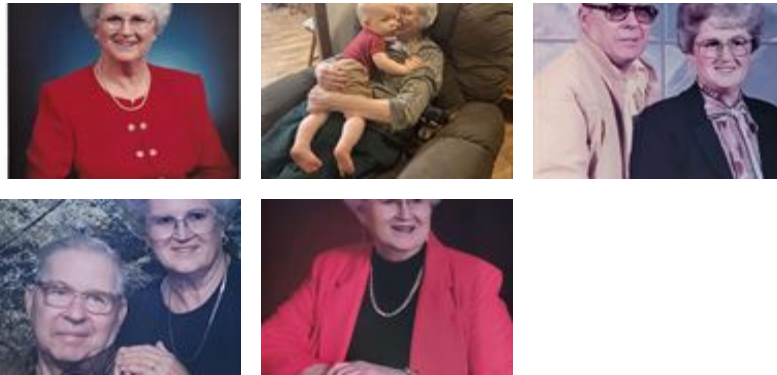
