Dorothea Lee (Thomas) Wise passed away Friday, February 1, 2019 at her Okmulgee home at 105 years of age. She was born Friday, October 17, 1913 in Prague, Lincoln County, Oklahoma to the late Richard P. and Lillie E. (Trammell) Thomas. Dorothea graduated from the University of Oklahoma in 1934. She married Carnie W. Wise on January 10, 1937 and they moved to Okmulgee from Shamrock, Texas. Dorothea taught at the Episcopal Day School. She and Carnie were co-owners of Buchanan-Wise-McClendon Funeral Home for several years. She loved to read and cooked for her family until she was 100. She enjoyed playing golf and bridge, and spending time at the lake. Dorothea was a member of the Episcopal Church of the Redeemer and PEO Chapter ER.
