Doyle Ray Henson, resident of Okmulgee, died in Okmulgee on Sunday, February 6, 2011. He was 90 years old. Doyle was born on January 16, 1921 in Hoyt, Oklahoma to E.O. and Ida Mae (Justice) Henson. He was a WWII Army/Air Force Veteran. He flew sixteen missions over Germany as a radio man and waist gunner on a B-17 Bomber. On August 27, 1954 he married Juanita Smith. In the 70's and 80's he owned and raced thoroughbred horses. Doyle loved sports and was an avid OU football fan.

He was preceded in death by his four brothers: A.C. Henson, Clell Henson, Melvin Don Henson and Fervin Henson.

Doyle is survived by his wife Juanita of the home, three sons: Daryl Henson of Morris, Terry Henson of Tulsa, and Kevin Henson of Okemah, one daughter Janine Dale and husband Bob of Okmulgee, seven grandchildren: Holly, Heather, Jessica, Phillip, Connor, Kristen, and Taylor, one great grandchild: Evan, and two sisters: Ilda Presley of Seminole and Wanona Pinkard of Texas.
