Duane Welty Lewis of Okmulgee, passed away Saturday, March 18, 2017 at his home. He was 84 years of age. He was born September 17, 1932 in Enid, Oklahoma to the late Fred and Mae LaVina Lewis. Duane inducted Elvis Presley into the United States Army while serving his country. He later received his B.S. in Marketing and worked for Oklahoma Natural Gas as a Sales Representative. He loved quail hunting and was a Charter Member of the Grand National Quail Hunt. Duane enjoyed playing golf and was a very talented pianist, often playing at local nursing homes and events. He was a former member of the Okmulgee Elks Lodge and Crosstown Pentecostal Holiness Church. He attended Boston Avenue United Methodist Church.
