Dwight G. Wofford, passed away June 5, 2024, in Tulsa, Oklahoma at the age of 80. He was born on May 22, 1944, in Siloam Springs, Arkansas to Joe and Elizabeth (Johnson) Wofford.

Dwight grew up in the Oaks Community and graduated from Oaks High School. He proudly joined and served in the United States army after and did a tour in Vietnam. After serving two years in the United States army, he transferred to the United States Army reserves and retired as a drill sergeant in 1994. During this time, Dwight had moved to the Tulsa area where he began his career with the United States army corps of engineers. He worked in various locations and moved to Marshall Texas with his wife Joyce. They were members of the VFW American Legion, and the Elks Lodge. They then settled in Colbert, Oklahoma until his retirement from the core of engineers. Dwight did not like sitting still, leading him to take a job with the Chickasaw nation, delivering meals to homebound senior citizens.
