



## Earl Stuart Hadley

August 31, 1929 - June 30, 2013

Earl Stuart Hadley died suddenly, June 30, at Okmulgee Memorial Hospital. He was 83 years old.

He was born the son of Arthur Robert Hadley and Arlene Stewart Hadley on August 31, 1929 in Kane, Pennsylvania. He was preceded in death by his parents; his sister, Margaret Ann; and a grandson, Christopher Eric Hadley. He is survived by: His wife, the former Cornelia Flo Petre of the home; his son Eric, of Okmulgee; and his son Robert, daughter-in-law Karen and grandson Ben of Farmington, Ark.

His family moved to Okmulgee in 1948 shortly after he completed high school in New Kensington, Pennsylvania. He came with the family to Oklahoma and served two years in the U.S. Navy. While he was stationed at Memphis, Tenn., he met his bride, a schoolteacher from Hope, Ark. They would have been married 60 years July 17th.

He worked as a glass cutter for Pittsburgh Plate Glass in Henryetta. He also worked, from time to time, at the American Window Glass Co. in Okmulgee. Later, he was moved to a time-study position at PPG and finished his career with the company in the packaging division. When the plant in Henryetta closed in 1974, he was offered a job with the company in Minnesota, but chose to stay in Okmulgee County, making his moonlighting job fixing televisions his everyday job.

For thirty-five more years, until he reached the age of 80, Earl repaired televisions for those in Okmulgee County, and points beyond. He was known

for his integrity, his skill and his generosity.

He was a member of the Morris Lions' Club and was deeply involved in its activities and projects for almost fifty years.

A memorial service will be at McClendon-Winters Funeral Home Friday, July 5 at 10:00 A.M. conducted by his son, Robert.
