



## Elizabeth A. "Becky" Lewis

Elizabeth Ann "Becky" Lewis, age 64, a resident of Broken Arrow, passed away Saturday morning, February 4, 2012 at Saint Francis Hospital South in Tulsa. Becky was born August 12, 1947 in Okmulgee to Fred and Betty (Dunagan) Lewis. She graduated from Okmulgee High School in 1965 and at the age of 19 moved with her parents and sisters to Georgia where she began her long career working as a telephone operator.
