Emily Jane Simmons Hubbell was born September 16, 1943 in Rhome, Texas to the late Emma Jean Brown Simmons and Martin Ezra Simmons. She passed away at her Beggs residence on August 29, 2016 with her husband and daughter by her side.

Jane learned to play the piano and organ at an early age, playing in church for revivals, weddings and funerals and accepted Christ at an early age. She married Bobby Wayne Hubbell on November 29, 1963 and together they had two beautiful daughters, Julie Lyn and Jill Annette. While living in Texas, Jane worked for the telephone company and later in the medical field until 1995, when her and Bobby retired to Beggs. 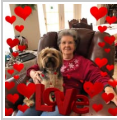
