



## Ernest E. Clark

April 6, 1927 - April 2, 2010

Ernest E. "Ernie" Clark, Jr., lifelong Okmulgee area resident, died Friday, April 2, 2010 at Okmulgee Memorial Hospital. He was 82 years of age. Ernie was born April 6, 1927 in Okmulgee to Ernest E. Clark, Sr. and Edith Ann (Brumback) Clark. He served his country in the United States Army and after discharge married Anna Louise Harmon on September 27, 1952 in Ft. Smith, Arkansas. Ernie worked for Western Union as a singing telegraph boy and was an official telegraph delivery person during WWII, delivering death notices to families. He later worked for 20 ½ years as a glass worker at American St. Gobain and was an E.M.T. for Okmulgee for several years. He retired from George Nigh Rehabilitation Center as a nursing assistant. He was a member of the United Pentecostal Church of Morris and belonged to the American Legion for many years. Ernie was preceded in death by his parents, wife, Anna, and a brother, J.W. Clark. Survivors include a son, Larry, two daughters, Judy Stacy and husband Michael and Rebecca King and husband David, fourteen grandchildren, Michael and Jennifer Stacy, Chris and Audrey Stacy, Andy Clark, Tina Qualls, Amanda and Randy Clark, Jennifer Hart, Ike Clark, Misty, Peggy and Tiffany Bell and Misty Dillard, and fifteen great grandchildren.
