



Ethel "Irene" Grogan

August 1, 1930 - May 28, 2024

Ethel "Irene" Grogan, a lifelong Okmulgee resident, died at the age of 93, May 28, 2024, at Clarehouse in Tulsa, Oklahoma. 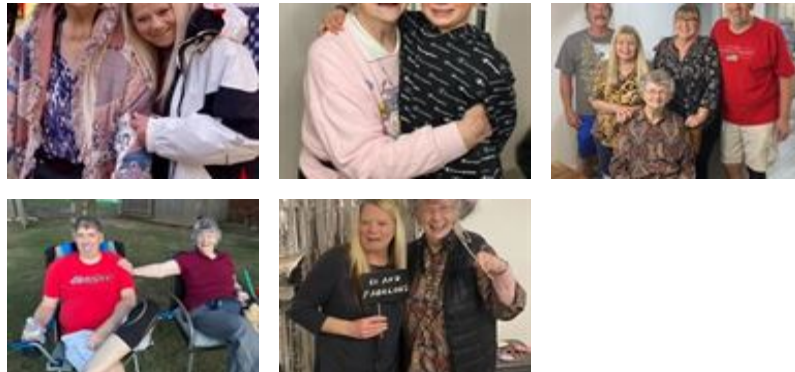
