



Evelyn Ann Briscoe

September 27, 1918 - March 1, 2012

Evelyn Ann Briscoe, longtime Okmulgee resident and a resident of Shawnee, passed away Thursday morning, March 1, 2012 in Shawnee at the age of 93. She was born September 27, 1918 in Okmulgee. Evelyn graduated from Okmulgee High School in 1936 and Oklahoma State University in 1941. She worked at the Phillips Refinery until 1945, and married Roy F. Briscoe, Sr. on December 1, 1945 at the First Presbyterian Church in Okmulgee. Evelyn remained a very active member of the church for 84 years. She was also a member of the Investment Club, Garden Club, Book Club, three Bridge Groups and was an avid OU Football Fan. She loved to travel the world and enjoyed many trips to Europe. She was known for feeding the birds at her home and the love she had for her grandchildren. She moved to Shawnee 6 ½ years ago to be closer to her family.

Evelyn was preceded in death by her father, Mr. Mitchell, mother, Maude (Richardson) Griffin, step-father, John Griffin, husband, Roy F. Briscoe, Sr., an infant son, Timothy Lee Briscoe and a brother, Leo Shuppert.

Survivors include her sons, Roy F. Briscoe, Jr. and wife Marva of Knoxville, Tennessee and J. Clifton Briscoe of Shawnee, four grandchildren and ten great grandchildren.

Funeral services will be held 2:00 P.M. Saturday, March 3, 2012 at the First

Presbyterian Church in Okmulgee with Reverend J. Clifton Briscoe and Reverend Jennifer Grantham officiating.
