Frankie Jean Ritter, longtime Okmulgee resident, passed away Monday morning, July 31, 2017 in Bristow at 94 years of age. She was born the eighth of nine children to the late Joseph and Liza (Sanders) Parker on August 23, 1922 in Wetumka. She graduated from Fairview High School. Frankie married C.L. Ritter on May 31, 1947. She retired two times from Sears where worked in the linen department well into her 80's. 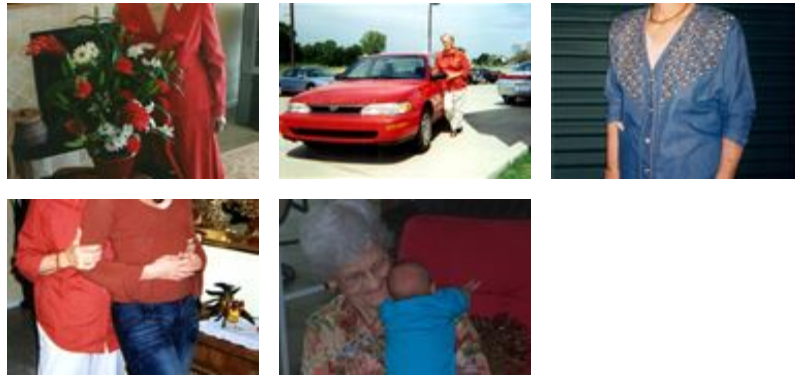
