Fred Jones, longtime Okmulgee resident, died Saturday morning, July 24, 2010 at St. Francis Hospital. Fred was born November 2, 1948 in Okfuskee to Walter and Mary Jane (Yahola) Jones. He served his country in the United States Navy, receiving an honorable discharge in 1970. He married Sandra K. Rainbolt on April 11, 1970 in Okmulgee. Fred was a graduate of OSU-Okmulgee, receiving his Associates Degree in Culinary Arts and retired as a baker in 2006. Fred was a member of Montesoma Baptist Church and was Chairman of the Randall Mission. He received his minister's license January 18, 2009.
