My deepest sympathy to all of the family. You are in my prayers and thoughts.

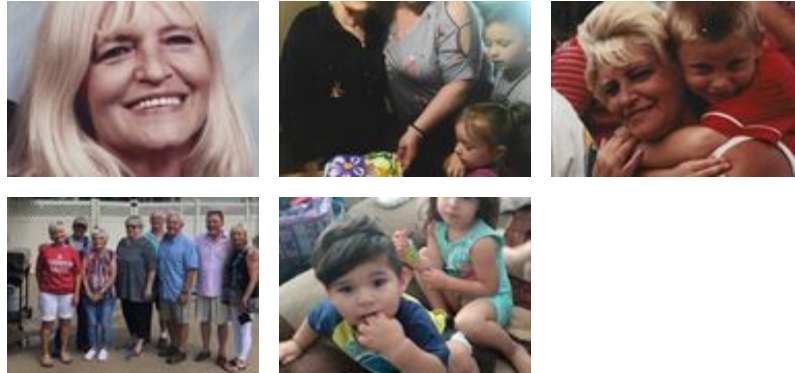
