George An Harding, age 85, of Okmulgee, gained his wings on September 19, 2023 at 2:20 A.M. He was born on June 1, 1938, in Winslow, Arkansas to John and Hanna (Purdue) Harding. George is preceded in death by his parents, eight sisters and two brothers.

At the young age of eighteen, George joined the U.S. Navy to serve his country. He was stationed in Boston, Massachusetts on the Aircraft Carrier, The Wasp. 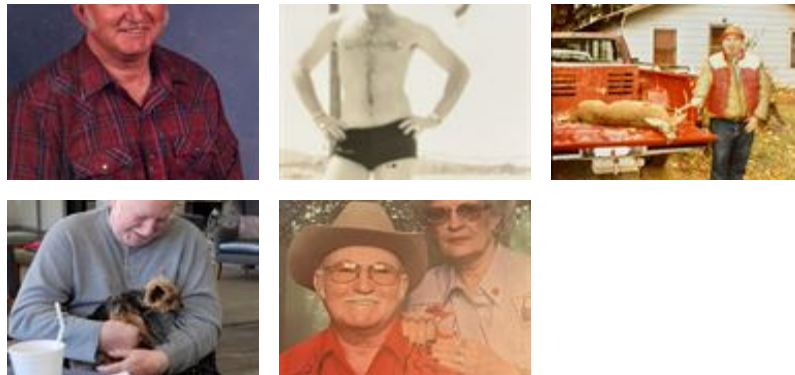
