Glen Charles Earnest, lifelong Okmulgee area resident, died Wednesday afternoon, June 10, 2015 at Highland Park Manor in Okmulgee. He was 92 years of age. Glen was born February 7, 1923 near the Morse Community of Okfuskee County. He graduated from Nuyaka High School and served his country in the United States Army during World War II.
