Gregory B. Robbins, 70 year old Okmulgee resident, passed away Wednesday, September 6, 2017 in Tulsa. He was born December 17, 1946 in Amarillo, Texas. He received his Master's Degree at Texas A&M. Greg married Mary Jones on January 28, 1967 in Seminole, Texas. They celebrated their 50th Wedding Anniversary this past January. Greg was an outstanding husband, father and grandfather, who was very generous and outgoing. His greatest love and pride was his family. 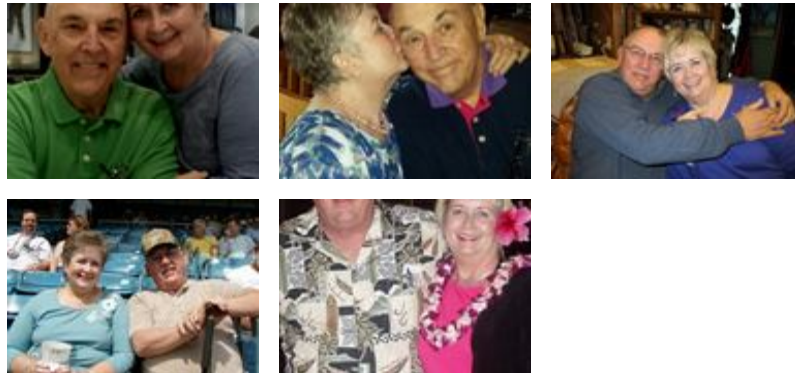
