Harvey Jackson Torix, Sr. died in Tulsa on Friday, June 1, 2012 at 82 years of age. Harvey was born on April 7, 1930 in Eufaula, Oklahoma to Edward Clarence and Hattie Torix. He was a veteran of the United States Army and served during the Korean War. Harvey worked as a Machinist Millwright for Ball Glass and had received the Manager's Merit Award. He was there for many years before retiring. He enjoyed being outdoors, hunting, fishing and flying as a private pilot. Harvey was a member of the Elk's Lodge.

His parents, four sisters and one brother preceded him in death.
