August 6, 1926 - January 22, 2011

Hazel Pauline Morrow, longtime Okmulgee resident, died Saturday morning, January 22, 2011 at the age of 84. Pauline was born August 6, 1926 in Nuyaka, Oklahoma to James and Evie Reeder. Pauline played basketball during high school at Nuyaka and later graduated from Clovis High School in California. She married Dan Morrow on June 30, 1946 in Okmulgee. Pauline was a homemaker for many years and later worked as a secretary at Okmulgee Anesthesiologists, Inc. Pauline was affectionately called “GaGa” by her grandchildren and many “adopted grandchildren.” She was also known as “Mama Pauline” by the many kids she “adopted.” Pauline was a member of the 1st Assembly of God Church in Okmulgee where she enjoyed singing specials. She loved her church and her ladies group. She also enjoyed camping at the lake with her husband, doing comedy skits, and for many years bowled in local leagues. In later years, Pauline enjoyed watching classic movies and working her word search books. She was also an avid Dallas Cowboys fan.

She was preceded in death by her parents, husband, Dan Morrow; daughter Hazel Morris, son-in-law, Jerry Morris and her 12 siblings.
