Henry Carl Stone, longtime Okmulgee resident, passed away Friday, October 22, 2021 in Okmulgee at 87 years of age. Henry was born August 1, 1934 in Shamrock, Oklahoma to the late Delmer Orval and Inta Deloris (Thompson) Stone. He married Orlene Wagoner on September 24, 1952 in Bristow. Henry had a military career that spanned forty-one years, retiring as a Chief Warrant Officer from the Army National Guard on July 31, 1994. He was a member of the First Baptist Church of Okmulgee and formerly the Okmulgee Kiwanis Club and the Winnebago Club.

Henry enjoyed woodworking and traveling throughout North American in his Winnebago.

He was preceded in death by his parents and seven siblings.

Survivors include his wife of 69 years, Orlene, a son, Mike Stone and wife Tami, a daughter, Karen Starr and husband Emmitt, grandchildren, Jerry McCroskey and wife Jennifer, Tia Stone, Ted Sharp, Farrah Seay and husband Matthew and Desiree Keomany and husband P.K., several great grandchildren, a sister, Helen Johnson and numerous nieces and nephews.
