Herbert "Herb" Carter, 92, died in Okmulgee on Sunday, July 4, 2010. Herb was born in Morris, Oklahoma to Herbert Sr. and Dona (Hughes) Carter. He joined the U.S. Army, married Anita Vivar on July 4, 1943. As Anita mentioned she got him on July 4th. and lost him on July 4th. Herb was one of the best mechanics around, co-owning the Herb and Elbert's Garage for years and worked at OSUIT as an auto mechanic instructor. He also developed and was co-owner of Belle Starr Marina in 1964 on Lake Eufaula selling out on 1978. He was the master fisherman of Okmulgee, leading many yearly trips to Mexico with several friends. Herb as a Lifetime member of the Elks Lodge and the VFW and a member of the First Baptist Church.. His parents a brother Harold Carter, and two sisters Maxine Martin and Edith Breeden preceded him in death.
