Jack E. Bell, Beggs resident and businessman, passed away Wednesday, September 8, 2021 at his home. He was born February 5, 1947 in Okmulgee to Fred and Mary Lou (Cockrum) Bell. Jack graduated from Beggs High School, Northeastern State University and Oklahoma State University. He taught Industrial Arts in Kansas City, Kansas; Jay, Oklahoma; and at Beggs before starting Bell's Backhoe and Dozer Services in 1977. His passion for cars, especially hot rods also led him to start an auto repair service. He enjoyed showing cars and racing. Jack loved collecting Cushman Motorcycles and was a member of the Cushman Club of America. In 2015 Jack became a Professional Santa, working at the Polar Express, Christmas Unwrapped and many other venues over the past six years. He also served as Mayor of Beggs for several years.

Jack was raised at the First Assembly of God in Beggs. He was united in marriage with Freda Wynn on June 7, 1974 in Mounds.

Jack is preceded in death by his father and a nephew, Chris Bell.

Survivors include his wife, Freda Bell, a son, Rodney Bell, a daughter, Mary Bell, his mother, Mary Lou Bell, a brother, John Bell and wife Kathryn and their son, Jesse and numerous nieces and nephews.

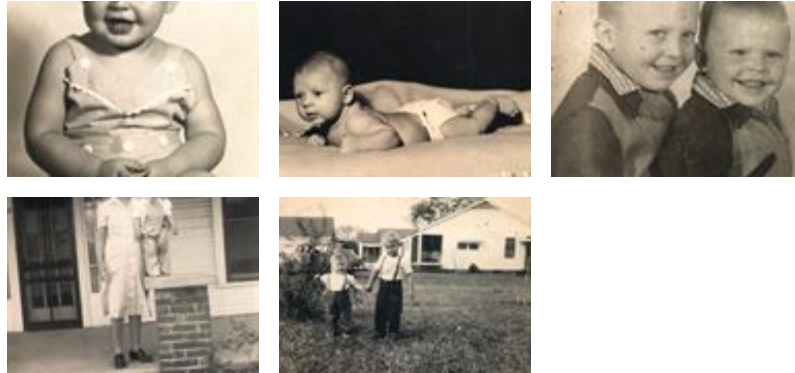
