Jeffery Michael Leach, 36 year old Jenks resident, passed away Sunday, November 12, 2017 at his home surrounded by his family. He was born October 15, 1981 in Ada, Oklahoma to Jesse Wayne and Patricia Jo (Clifford) Leach. He graduated from Henryetta High School in 2000 and in 2003 joined the U.S. Army. Jeff served overseas for 13 months during the Iraq War and was honorable discharged in September 2008. He then attended OSU-Okmulgee earning an Associate Degree in 2010. He worked for Diversified as a lineman. Jeff and Nikki Dunham were married on May 4, 2013 in Okmulgee. He loved yardwork and cutting down trees. He was an avid OU Football fan. 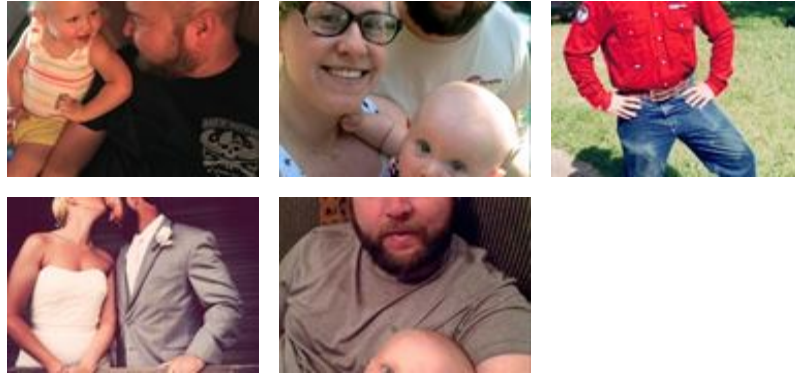

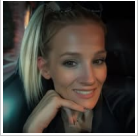
