

## Jimmy Ray Chrysler

December 22, 1951 - November 8, 2019

Jimmy Ray Chrysler passed away suddenly November 8, 2019 at St. Francis Hospital in Tulsa with his family by his side. Jimmy was born to James Leo and Betty Annie Louise (Dry) Chrysler on December 22, 1951. He attended school in Tulsa and was a 1970 graduate of Daniel Webster High School. Jimmy served in the United States Air Force for four years and four months, receiving an honorable discharge in 1975. Jimmy worked for a short period of time for Unit Rig and Equipment while waiting for a position with the U.S. Postal Service, from which he retired on June 30 of 2019 with 42 years of service.

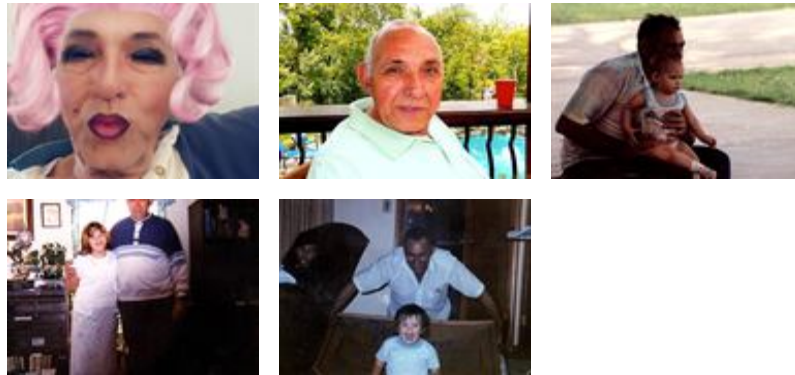
