Jo Anna was a member of the Big Cussetah Indian United Methodist Church. Jo Anna's spiritual life and belief in God and Jesus Christ was the cornerstone of her life. She ensured her family had a personal relationship with God and used her teachings in her work and encouragement of others. Jo Anna

enjoyed life and loved spending time with her family. Her husband, children, and grandchildren were the light of her life. Jo Anna also loved cheering for the OSU Cowboys, attending concerts, shopping, and traveling to Taos, New Mexico in the summertime. We are comforted knowing that she is completely healed and rejoicing in Heaven.
