John Allen Grammer, Sr, longtime Morris resident, passed away Friday morning, April 7, 2017 at 94 years of age. 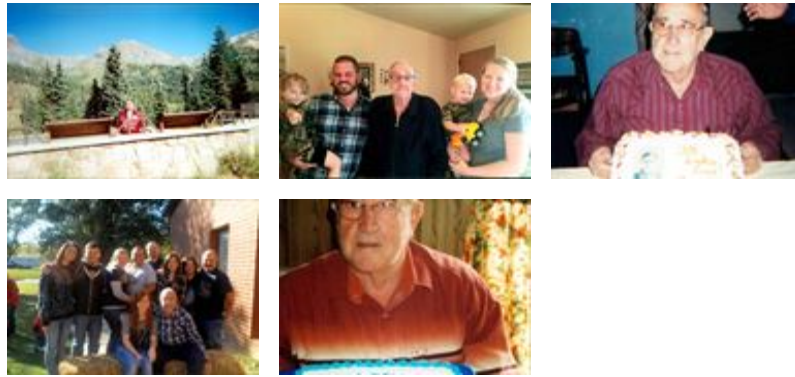
