John Eldon Kutz was born July 24, 1944, in Wentworth, Missouri to John and Evelyn Kellhoffer Kutz. He passed from this life on Friday, August 21, 2015 in Tulsa, Oklahoma after a brief battle with cancer at the age of 71. John grew up in southwest Missouri. In 1977, he moved to Morris. He worked at Burlington Northern Railroad in Tulsa, Oklahoma for 20 years. He retired from Burlington Northern Railroad as a conductor in 1988. Since retirement he has raised cattle and horses. 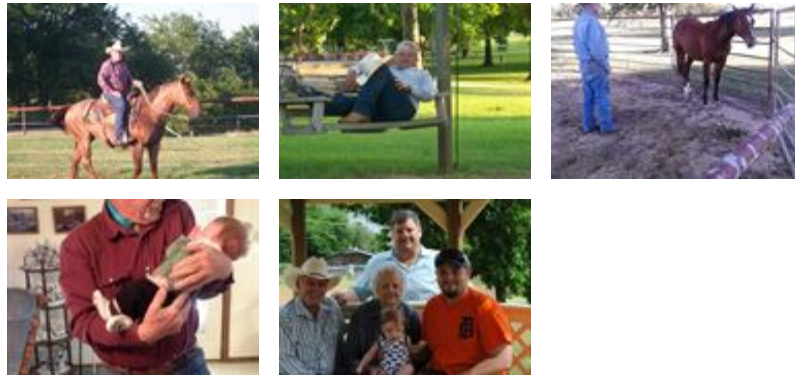

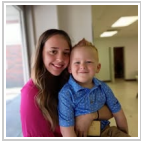

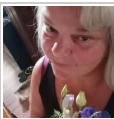
