Johnnie Lou Bingman-Dugger 89, longtime prominent resident of Okmulgee, died Thursday, June 4, 2009 in Okmulgee. She was born September 9, 1919 in Wright City, Oklahoma to John Howard and Ruby Gay Sorrells Brown. Johnnie Lou moved to Okmulgee with her family in 1922 and attended Okmulgee Public Schools graduating in 1937. She then attended Lindenwood College in St. Charles, Missouri. After returning to Okmulgee she married James B. Bingman in 1939. James preceded her in death in 1978 and she married Stanley Dugger in 1983 and he preceded her in death in 1997. She was employed at Citizens National Bank and Trust from 1953 until her retirement in 1987. She had the position of Vice President and Trust Officer with the bank.
