Johnny Wayne Johnson passed away Monday, April 10, 2023 at the VA Eastern Oklahoma Healthcare Center in Muskogee. He was seventy-five years of age. Johnny was born Friday, June 6, 1947 in Seminole, Oklahoma to the late Earl C. and Pauline L. (Goodell) Johnson. He proudly served his country in the United States Air Force and was honorably discharged on March 10, 1970.
