Josephine Lenore Thomas, 90, lifelong Okmulgee resident, died Thursday, June 17, 2010 at Okmulgee Memorial Hospital. She was born October 28, 1919 in Okmulgee to Joe and Edith (Wyrick) Hardridge. She worked for many years as a bookkeeper at Johnson Butane and Propane and later at Creek Nation Housing and the Bureau of Indian Affairs. She was a tribal member of the Muscogee (Creek) Nation. Josephine enjoyed playing the piano, sewing, reading and playing bridge. She was a member of the First Presbyterian Church, where she had been active for many years, the Wednesday Morning Music Club, Bridge Club and the Garden Club. She was preceded in death by her parents, husband, Robert Thomas, and two brothers, Richard and Joe T. Hardridge. Survivors include her daughter, Juliene Stone, of Okmulgee, grandchildren, Dianne M. Jones of Okmulgee, Suzanne Shields of Spokane, Washington, Robert T. Stone of Dover, Pennsylvania, and great grandchildren, Olen and Alison Shields and Alexander Gilmore, all of Spokane, Washington, Thomas and Jon Stone of Dover, Pennsylvania and Dylan T. Jones of Okmulgee. Funeral services will be held 10:00 A.M. Monday, June 21, 2010 at the First Presbyterian Church with Reverend Jennifer Grantham officiating.
